

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Schuylkill Township, Chester County will receive sealed bids online for the **Schuylkill Township Road Department Garage Project**. Sealed bids may be submitted and updated online via the **PennBid™** Program until **11:00 A.M. local time, Thursday, May 30, 2019**. The bids shall be publicly opened and read aloud at the Schuylkill Township Municipal Building, 111 Valley Park Road, Phoenixville, PA 19460 at **2:00 P.M. local time on Thursday May 30, 2019**.

The project includes providing all labor, equipment and materials to complete the construction of a new garage building at the Schuylkill Township municipal complex.

All Bid Documents and solicitation details will be available on **Tuesday April 30, 2019** at no cost at PennBid™ - www.PennBid.net. Click on the "Solicitations" then "View" tabs. Please note the low bidder is responsible for a fee to PennBid™.

A non-mandatory Pre-Bid Conference will be held at 10:00 A.M. local time on Friday May 3, 2019 at the Schuylkill Township Municipal Building, 111 Valley Park Road, Phoenixville, PA 19460.

Questions will be accepted through PennBid™ only until 12:00 PM local time on Friday May 17, 2019.

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond or a certified check in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount of the bid in the form and subject to the conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. No bid may be withdrawn for the period of days stated in the bid form from the date the bids are opened. The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance and Payment Bonds in the amount of 100% of the Contract amount and a Maintenance Bond in the amount equal to fifteen percent (15%) of the contract amount, thereafter required on the specified Bond Forms included in the Contract Documents and Waiver of Liens.

This project is subject to applicable provisions of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act (Act No. 442) as amended and the prevailing minimum wage rates issued by the Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry.

This project is also subject to Act 127 of 2012, known as the Public Works Employment Verification Act, which requires all public work contractors and subcontractors to utilize the Federal Government's E-Verify system to ensure that all employees performing work on public work projects are authorized to work in the United States.

Schuylkill Township reserves the right to waive any informality in the Bid, to reject any or all Bids, to eliminate any item or items from the contract, and to accept any Bid which is deemed most favorable to the Owner, at the time and under the circumstances stipulated.
